Komi Republic, Russia

Sergei ministers in the Komi Republic, at the same latitude as Siberia and Alaska but west of the Ural Mountains. In one Komi village, Sergei's team visited people door-to-door, inviting them to see *JESUS* in a movie hall. The facility was falling apart and had no heat, but as it was summer, this did not pose a problem. The team needed only a place to block out the bright 9:00 p.m. sunlight. The film workers visited one Komi home, where the skinny barefoot children touched their hearts. They invited the family to the free showing, but the parents' only response was to ask for money for food. Knowing that any money they gave the family would most likely be used to buy alcohol, the team members promised they would give the children fruit if the whole family attended the screening sober. It worked! The parents came sober with all of the children, and the film team workers gave them all apples. They guessed it had been a long time since these children of the far North had tasted fruit. That day the family began a new life. After seeing *JESUS*, the parents repented of their sins and gave their lives to Christ. Now all the family members are attending a local church fellowship and are growing spiritually.
