There is one story that I want to share. Not too long ago I received a phone call, asking how to get a copy of the film. A woman from Iran was in the states visiting her son and his American wife. While her son was at work, the mother was unable to communicate. My friend thought it would be a nice thing for her to have something to watch in her own language, and of course the gospel is the best thing she could see. The mother does have a Bible in her language and reads it. Here is part of a note I was sent afterwards.

*"When she played it, the mother was so excited that it was in her own language... When Jesus was nailed to the cross she was wiping tears from her eyes.*

*Although she can't understand the bible study, she goes and 'rocks babies,' and apparently the nursery worker attempts to communicate with her. After she had watched the JESUS video she said to the nursery worker, "Jesus in my heart." No one knows where she could have gotten those English words.*

*It never ceases to amaze me how the Lord has just the right people available to get the message across to a hungry heart. And we know, too, that He is the one who makes the heart hungry."*
