The danger to the voice actors is so great that they were flown out of the country to record, and we only talk about the language by a dummy name so that it doesn't accidentally get out. I have disguised the voices to minimize the danger to those involved once the film is distributed. The people who speak this language currently have no Bible translation, not even fragments; the only resource in the language are the stories of the lost sheep and prodigal son. Six minutes of audio. That's not much! So having the complete "JESUS" film will be a big step in bringing the gospel to this Muslim people group. Please be praying.

one person... October and November...

... that would be me going to Detroit from October 29 through November 18. When we were up this summer it was over the fourth of July. What was I thinking? I felt pretty bad that we didn't really get to see many people.

Here is our need so you can be thinking and praying about it. We need to meet new people! That is it, plain and simple.
